Instructions

- Get a group together – friends/family/organisation
- Choose a product – clothing/trainers/toys, etc
- Source fairly traded raw materials
- Cost out your product and decide on a retail price
- Design a poster to promote your product

Rules

- All raw materials must be fairly traded
- The poster along with a list of the raw materials & sources must be submitted to The Wesley Centre by 12 noon on Saturday 2nd March
- The judge's decision is final
- Prize – sharing box of Meaningful Chocolate Thin Squares

THE GREAT FAIRTRADE BAKE-OFF RULES

Instructions

- Choose a recipe (*hint: search 'Fairtrade recipes' on Google*)
- Source as many fairly traded ingredients as possible
- Bake your cake

Rules

- Your bake must include as many fairly traded ingredients as possible and these must be marked on your recipe
- Your bake along with the recipe (marked with fairly traded ingredients) must be submitted to The Wesley Centre by 1.30pm on Saturday 2nd March
- The competition will be judged by a public taste-test & vote.
- Prize - Traidcraft recipe book "Bake a Difference"
